The road allowance is within the Rural Municipality of Kindersley No. 290;

The residence located within the NE 01-28-27W3 is only occupied during the crop season;

The yard site within the NE 01-28-27W3 is owned by ratepayers with land in both the RM of Milton No. 292 and the RM of Kindersley No. 290;

The RM of Milton No. 292 council does not agree that a 28-foot road top is necessary for this construction.
